Simcoe County Forests Recreation Policy Summary



FACT SHEET

Background

The County of Simcoe conducted an extensive review of the recreational use of County Forests in 2006. As a result, County Council adopted a new Recreation Policy, effective January 1, 2007.

Activities Permitted

- Walking and hiking
- Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing
- Orienteering and geocaching
- Nature appreciation and study
- Dogsledding
- Horseback riding
- Dog walking
 - Pets must be under control or on leash
- Mountain biking
 - No unauthorized trail construction
- Hunting and fishing
 - As per provincial hunting and fishing regulations**
 - Portable tree stands only
 - Hunters must be members of Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters
- Trapping
 - License and Use Agreement required
- Harvesting non-wood forest products
 - Personal use only

- Snowmobiling
 - On designated Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs¹ trails only*
 - Use Agreement and permits are required
- Other off-road motorized vehicles (ATV's, motorcycles)
 - On designated Ontario Federation of All Terrain Vehicles² or Ontario Federation of Trail Riders³ trails only*
 - Use Agreement and permits are required
 - Maximum vehicle weight 400 kg

*Exceptions include:

- Use by Ontario Federation of All Terrain Vehicles, Ontario Federation of Snomobile Clubs or Ontario Federation of Trail Riders members where authorizes to facilitate volunteer patrols or stewardship activites
- To assist disabled or infirm hunters to access the Simcoe County Forests during all hunting seasons
- To faciilitate large game retrieval (deer and bear)
- To facilitate complete access for hunters to the Simcoe County Forests during the Controlled Deer Hunt only
- ** Hunting is permitted except on the following tracts due to close proximity to urban areas:
 - Dyer (City of Barrie)
 - Rippon (Essa Township)
 - Blaucham (Town of Innisfil)
 - Museum (Springwater Township)
 - Thompson (Town of Penetanguishene)
- Tottenham (Town of New Tecumseth)

Activities Not Permitted:

- Operation of motorized vehicles in excess of 400 kg gross vehicle weight
- Littering, dumping or disposal of any foreign material
- Open fires
- Camping
- Consumption of alcohol
- Target practice; paintball
- Cutting, pruning, digging or gathering of trees, shrubs, groundcover or firewood
- Construction of unauthorized structures; permanent tree stands
- Placement of unauthorized signs
